Each week we will have an Eco Tip for the Congregation from Carmen and the EcoChurch group:

### This Week's Eco Tip

**Food shopping:** we tend to use supermarkets for our food shopping as they are cost-effective and very convenient. However, they have all been incredibly slow to adopt plastic free shopping, and still cover most of their products in plastic. Alternatives include the following:

- Use the market for fruit and veg and other products - very good value for money, can use brown paper bags, good selection, including organic and you get the person centred approach!
- "Milk and more" offer a variety of online food and drink shopping, which can be delivered to your door, as well as delivering traditional pints of milk in washed glass bottles. They are passionate about plastic free food, and can deliver fruit juices, cream, washing up liquid and machine washing detergent in re-usable glass bottles that are delivered and collected from your door. It is slightly more expensive than supermarket milk in plastic bottles, but you dramatically reduce the amount of plastic you have to recycle (energy inefficient) and by re-using i.e. washing bottles this is the most efficient way of recycling containers. I also use them for deliveries of sparkling water (in a glass bottle). They deliver using electric vans so very quiet, and eco-friendly.
- "Boxxfresh" - based in Fareham, deliver fruit and veg to your door completely plastic free. Their website has the advantage that you can select exactly which vegetables etc you want in your box, rather than a generic box. However, although good at the basics they do not have a huge selection to choose from.



## The Collect

Almighty God,  
in Christ you make all things new:  
transform the poverty of our nature by the riches of your  
grace,  
and in the renewal of our lives  
make known your heavenly glory;  
through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord,  
who is alive and reigns with you,  
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,  
one God, now and for ever. Amen.

## First Reading

*Isaiah 62.1-5*

For Zion's sake I will not keep silent,  
and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest,  
until her vindication shines out like the dawn,  
and her salvation like a burning torch.  
The nations shall see your vindication,  
and all the kings your glory;  
and you shall be called by a new name  
that the mouth of the LORD will give.  
You shall be a crown of beauty  
in the hand of the LORD,  
and a royal diadem in the hand of your God.  
You shall no more be termed Forsaken,  
and your land shall no more be termed Desolate;  
but you shall be called My Delight Is in Her,  
and your land Married;  
for the LORD delights in you,  
and your land shall be married.  
For as a young man marries a young woman,  
so shall your builder marry you,  
and as the bridegroom rejoices over the bride,  
so shall your God rejoice over you.

## Second Reading

*1 Corinthians 12.1-11*

Concerning spiritual gifts, brothers and sisters, I do not want you to be uninformed. You know that when you were pagans, you were enticed and led astray to idols that could not speak. Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking by the Spirit of God ever says 'Let Jesus be cursed!' and no one can say 'Jesus is Lord' except by the Holy Spirit.

Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of services, but the same Lord; and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone. To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. To one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the

discernment of spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. All these are activated by one and the same Spirit, who allots to each one individually just as the Spirit chooses.

## Gospel

*John 2.1-11*

On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. When the wine gave out, the mother of Jesus said to him, 'They have no wine.' And Jesus said to her, 'Woman, what concern is that to you and to me? My hour has not yet come.' His mother said to the servants, 'Do whatever he tells you.' Now standing there were six stone water-jars for the Jewish rites of purification, each holding twenty or thirty gallons. Jesus said to them, 'Fill the jars with water.' And they filled them up to the brim. He said to them, 'Now draw some out, and take it to the chief steward.' So they took it. When the steward tasted the water that had become wine, and did not know where it came from (though the servants who had drawn the water knew), the steward called the bridegroom and said to him, 'Everyone serves the good wine first, and then the inferior wine after the guests have become drunk. But you have kept the good wine until now.' Jesus did this, the first of his signs, in Cana of Galilee, and revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him.
